Before taking up regular agenda item(s), Prof. C. R. Choudhary on his own behalf and on behalf of all the members of the Syndicate welcomed Prof. B.R.Choudhary as Vice-Chancellor and Chairman of the Syndicate.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor placed on record the appreciation for the services rendered by the outgoing Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vishnu Sharma and also extended a warm welcome to the members of the Syndicate.

Prof. C.R. Choudhary, Member Syndicate raised a point of order that in the regular meeting items related to confirmation of minutes of last meeting of the Syndicate and Action Taken Report should be listed in the agenda.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor assured the house that in future these items will be listed in the agenda.

AGENDA ITEM NO.1 RES.NO. 37/2019

CONSIDERED the recommendations of the Statutory Selection Committee held on 10th, 11th and 27th November, 2016 for promotion under CAS to the Teachers of General Faculties in various subjects to the post of Professor (Stage-5) in accordance with Ordinances 317 (B) dated 18.03.2013, who were interviewed on different dates in November, 2016. This is in compliance to the order dated 19.12.2016 of the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court passed in SB Civil Writ petition No. 13074/2016.


By order dated 19.12.2016, the respondents were directed as under:-

- (a)- to declare the result of 08 petitioners, who have been interviewed by the respective interview boards in terms of the interim orders passed by this Court within a period of 10 days,
- (b)- the petitioners, who have not been interviewed, shall be interviewed by the respective interview boards to be constituted by the respondent-University within a period of one month, and

(c)- based on the result of the above [(a or (b)] if found suitable within one week all the petitioners may be granted promotion to Stage 4/ the post of Professor (Stage 5) under CAS from the date persons similarly situated were granted promotion with all consequential benefits"

In view of the directions given by the Hon'ble High Court, the Syndicate considered the matter regarding the recommendations of the Selection Committee for promotion to the post of Professor under Career Advancement Scheme. Syndicate discussed and decided to bring in the record the following facts/orders/notifications/decisions related with the AGENDA ITEM NO. 1 before resolving the item.

- 1. Notification was issued by the University on 20.04.2016 for inviting Applications from eligible teachers for consideration of promotion under CAS to the higher post under Ordinance 317(B). This ordinance was effective upto or before 12.06.2013. The teachers who were appointed in the year 2013 also applied. But their Application forms were not scrutinized by the concerned Heads and Deans of the general faculties because the teachers appointed in the year 2013 were not covered under the Ordinance 317(B) upto or before 12.06.2013. (Annexure No. 01 Copy of the Ordinance)
- 2. On 23.09.2016, State Government also issued letter No. प.1(6)/शिक्षा-4/2010पार्ट to all the Universities to strictly follow the regulations of the UGC amended from time to time. (Annexure No. 2 State Government Letter).
- 3. On 20 Oct 2016, Notification was issued by the University, for promotion of the teachers under the Proposed Ordinance 317–B, applicable from 13.06.2013 onwards. Applications were received but some of the Heads and Deans of the General Faculties refused to scrutinize the Appraisal Forms, therefore, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor constituted a committee consisting of the Deans of Faculty of Science, Commerce and Arts on 03.11.2016. The Committee submitted its Report on 05.11.2016. (Annexure No. 03 Report of the Committee of Deans)
- 4. Proposed Ord. 317(B) got assented by the Hon'ble Chancellor vide letter No. 5227 dated 30.06.2017 and notified by the University vide Notification No. 4180 dated 20.07.2017 which was applicable to the candidates who become eligible for promotion under CAS on or after 13.06.2013.
- 5. Some teachers including Dr. Ganpat Singh and Dr. Sunil Asopa approached the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court with the prayer to direct the respondents to call the petitioners for the interview and consider them for promotion.
- 6. As per the direction of the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court, University scrutinized the Forms and documents of the teachers in which some of the teachers were found eligible and were interviewed by the University in November 2016. (Annexure No. 04 Scrutiny Committee Report.)
- 7. In the Writ petition No. 13067/2016-Dr. Beena TripathiVs. J.N. Vyas University, Jodhpur, the Hon'ble High Court vide its order directed the University to bring the result of the Petitioners in the sealed cover.
- 8. Order dated 19.12.2016, of the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court passed in SB Civil Writ petition No. 13074/2016, the respondents were directed as under:-



- (a)- to declare the result of 08 petitioners, who have been interviewed by the respective interview boards in terms of the interim orders passed by this Court within a period of 10 days,
- (b)- the petitioners, who have not been interviewed, shall be interviewed by the respective interview boards to be constituted by the respondent-University within a period of one month, and
- (c)- based on the result of the above [(a or (b)] if found suitable within one week all the petitioners may be granted promotion to Stage 4/ the post of Professor (Stage 5) under CAS from the date persons similarly situated were granted promotion with all consequential benefits"

- 9. An Appeal was filed by the University against the order dated 19.12.2016 which was disposed of on 11.08.2017.
- 10.On 22.01.2018, letter No. अतिपु/भ्रनिब्यूरो/जोध/18/95-96 was issued by ACB to University according to which question was raised on the process of CAS as the teachers selected in 2013 were not found eligible. (Annexure No. 05 Copy of the ACB letter)

11. In pursuance of this letter the committee was constituted by the University. Prof. P.K. Sharma, Committee were of the members Prof. S. Sundaramoorthy and Prof. S.K. Sharma. (Annexure No. 06 Report of the Committee.)

- 12.On 15th June 2018, a letter No. एफ.2(3)आरबी/2013/4870 from Secretary to Hon'ble Chancellor (Raj Bhawan) was received along with other related important documents (Annexure No. 07 Copy of the letter)
- 13. In pursuance of the letter of Raj Bhawan, a committee was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor consisting of Prof. R.K. Yadav, Prof. Rajat Bhagwat and Prof. Ravi Saxena.
- 14. Letter No. 4351-52 dated 27.08.2018 was sent by University to Secretary to the Hon'ble Governor and copy endorsed to ACS Higher Education. (Annexure No. 08 Copy of this letter.)
- 15.In reference to the above letter of the University, letter No.F/2(3) RB/2013/7436 dated 14.9.2018 was written to the ACS Higher Education by the Secretary to the Hon'ble Chancellor (Annexure No. 09)
- 16.Dr. Sunil Asopa and Dr. Ganpat Singh Deora approached the Hon'ble High Court by filing the contempt petition No.1306/2017- Dr. Sunil Asopa Vs. Shri Ayub Khan, Registrar, JNV University.
- 17. For compliance of order dated 19.12.2016 of Hon'ble High Court, the Registrar of the University was called for personal appearance before the Hon'ble Court on 5.9.2019.
- 18. For compliance of order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 19.12.2016 the Registrar of the University appeared before the Hon'ble High Court on 12.9.2019 and placed the agenda of the Syndicate meeting scheduled on 27.9.2019 before the Hon'ble High Court.

So far the University did not receive any direction from the Hon'ble Chancellor and Government of Rajasthan in pursuance of the letters dated 27.08.2018 and 14.09.2018. Meanwhile, on 5.9.2019 and 12.9.2019 Hon'ble High Court directed the University for compliance of order dated 19.12.2016. Therefore,
